



Dear Pleasantville Resident,

We are pleased to inform you that Noble Environmental has been awarded the contract for residential trash with optional recycling collection in Pleasantville beginning December 1st, 2025. We look forward to providing Pleasantville with a safe and efficient collection program! Our goal is always to attempt to keep collection days the same, but unfortunately that is not always possible. We will provide trash collection services every **Thursday beginning December 4th, 2025**. The optional recycling service will be provided each Thursday in the last full week of the month. Please refer to the attached calendar for additional information. **You must contact us to set up an account to receive this service.**

Visit <https://nobleenviro.com/pay-bill/> and select "Pay Your Bill" to access the payment portal OR using your iPhone/Android device, scan the QR Code below to go directly to our payment portal. Once registered, you can sign up for convenient automatic payments to be withdrawn from your payment method of choice. Automatic payments are an excellent option for those concerned with the security of their information when mailing checks and the costs associated with doing so.



The following guidelines apply to all residential trash and recycling collections in the Borough:

- Trash and recycling must be out the night before your collection day, or prior to 6 AM on the day of collection. Containers should be watertight, metal or plastic, with tight fitting covers and handles. Each container should not exceed 95 gallons; each plastic bag should not exceed 40 pounds.
- Recycling will begin on Friday December 26th, delayed one day due to Christmas, and will be collected **every month** on the same day as your trash during the last full week of the month.
- All containers and bulk items must be within five feet of the curb (or five feet from the edge of a traveled road) and placed so as not to interfere with the collection of other items, block the right of way or obstruct traffic. Items not visible or otherwise obstructed from view will not be collected.
- All trash **MUST BE BAGGED** before being placed in the trash can. Loose trash is a potential health hazard for our employees and is more difficult to collect and is a major factor in municipal litter. **DO NOT USE GROCERY BAGS, PAPER BAGS, CARDBOARD BOXES OR 55-GALLON DRUMS AS GARBAGE RECEPTACLES.**
- Please **DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLING**, it should be placed in the container loose. If you are placing loose cardboard out for recycling, please flatten all boxes and stack them neatly next to your recycling can.
- For our workers' protection mattresses and box springs must be wrapped in plastic and taped securely closed with duct or packing tape to prevent any possible exposure to infectious pests such as bedbugs, fleas, etc.
- Place all needles, syringes, and lancets in a hard-plastic container with a tight-fitting lid taped shut. Wrap all sharp objects, such as broken glass or sharp metal, in heavy paper and tape shut. Please protect our workers!
- See the attached calendar for the Holiday collection schedule. If a holiday falls on a weekday, collection is pushed back one day for all the days that follow.

Clear, brown, blue, and green glass food and beverage containers or jars will be accepted in your recycling containers.

Types 3-7 Plastics are no longer recyclable. There is no market for this material, so if it ends up in the recycling, it will be trucked to the recycling plant, then sorted and trucked to the landfill. The best way to reduce the carbon footprint of each item is to follow these guidelines closely and be sure to reach out to our Customer Service if you have any questions!

The two types of plastic that are still recyclable are **Types 1 & 2**, which are among the most common. Examples of Type 1 include soda, water, salad dressing and cooking oil bottles (either bottles you drink from, or that hold consumables). Some examples of Type 2 include milk and juice jugs, shampoo, conditioner or bodywash bottles and laundry detergents containers. Neither of these lists are comprehensive, so be sure to check each container for the recycling logo and the codes PET or PETE for Type 1 and PEHD or HDPE for Type 2. If the container has any of these codes or numbers 1 or 2 in the recycle triangle, it is recyclable. If it does not, then it is not recyclable.

All recyclables should be rinsed prior to depositing in your recycling bin. Food contamination may prevent items from being recycled when they arrive at the recycling plant.

The following rates will apply if you wish to participate in our services. The rates include a free trash cart and weekly collection services.

- **\$28.90/month for a Large Cart (96 gallons)**
- **\$27.90/month for a Medium Cart (65 gallons)**
- **\$26.90/month for a Small Cart (35 gallons)**
- **\$5.80/month additional for the Optional Monthly Recycling service**

We will need the following information to set up your account:

- First and last name
- Service address and billing address (if different)
- Phone number
- Email address (if you would prefer paperless billing)
- Size of trash cart that is to be provided to you
- If you would like to add the optional monthly recycling service
